C. 1900, Framed Gadsden Flag, 'Don't Tread On Me' (American). The Gadsden Flag is a historical American banner featuring a coiled rattlesnake and the motto "Don't Tread on Me" on a yellow field. Designed by American general Christopher Gadsden in 1775 during the Revolution, it originated as a symbol of unity against oppression.
