The composition depicts a jovial seated gentleman being embraced by a young woman while a companion pours wine at a nearby table, capturing the playful theatricality and narrative charm. Executed in oil on canvas and signed "H. Rayer" lower. The artist uncertain, though typical of Grützner-inspired tavern scenes The figures are animated and expressive, rendered with warm tonalities and rich period costume that evoke the lively atmosphere of a nineteenth-century drinking house.
