A concealed pull-out footrest extends smoothly to create a comfortable chaise-style seat, making this an exceptionally practical and desirable country house armchair. Upholstered in richly patinated leather, the chair displays the character and warmth that only age can produce, complementing the deep colour and figured grain of the mahogany frame. The combination of restrained William IV design, quality craftsmanship and ingenious engineering makes this an outstanding example of early Victorian comfort furniture.
