Charming 19th-century child's oak lambing chair, full of rustic character and the honest wear that comes with generations of use. Made from solid oak, the chair has the classic enclosed sides and high back associated with lambing chairs, designed to keep warmth in and draughts out — a practical farmhouse form scaled down for a child. The oak has developed a deep, mellow patina, with visible grain and age-softened edges that speak to its early rural origins. The seat is flat and sturdy, and the chair stands on straight legs with simple stretchers, giving it a pleasingly robust, no-nonsense presence. These small lambing chairs are increasingly hard to find, especially in untouched condition.
