Constructed from richly figured mahogany of excellent colour and quality, the cabinet features a pair of astragal glazed doors incorporating attractive geometric glazing bars with diamond motifs and shaped panels, creating a striking visual balance while allowing the contents to be displayed beautifully. The doors open to reveal a spacious shelved interior, ideal for housing books, antiques, porcelain, silver, glassware or decorative collections. Particularly impressive is the finely carved and pierced fretwork pediment surmounted by a classical urn finial and decorative laurel swags, reflecting the strong influence of eighteenth-century Chippendale designs. The quality of the carving throughout is exceptional, with intricate latticework decoration, finely moulded cornices and elegant architectural detailing rarely found on standard production pieces.
