The clock is a crystal regulator mantle clock. It features all glass sides with bevelled edges and very ornate corners with acanthus leaves on the bottom and figural masks on the top of the body. There is a finial and a raised area on the dome of the clock with Champleve detailing as well as around the base. This set would make a beautiful and quite striking focal point for a wide range of rooms and settings, both traditional and contemporary.
