Attributed to the renowned Chinese marine painter Lai Fong (Fl. 1870–1910), the ship is portrayed in starboard profile with remarkable nautical accuracy beneath a luminous sky and lively sea. This large maritime painting captures the elegance of one of Britain's finest merchant sailing vessels during the golden age of international trade. Composition & Technique The composition combines technical precision with strong decorative appeal. Finely painted rigging, fully set sails and a crisply rendered hull are complemented by rolling green seas and a soft blue sky illuminated by warm light. Signal flags and the British Red Ensign provide vibrant accents, while distant vessels add depth and atmosphere. About the Artist Attributed to Lai Fong (Fl. 1870–1910), a respected marine painter active in Calcutta during the late Victorian period. He specialised in portraits of merchant ships visiting one of the...
