Description

A fine pair of Chinese hardwood horseshoe back armchairs, dating to circa 1900, displaying the elegant curvature and refined joinery characteristic of late Qing dynasty craftsmanship. Each chair is constructed in dense, well-figured hardwood with a rich, dark patina, and features the traditional rounded horseshoe shaped crest rail flowing seamlessly into the arms. The backs are inset with intricately carved openwork panels, presenting stylised motifs executed with precision and balance. The square seats and straight legs are united by shaped stretchers, giving the chairs a stable, architectural presence. The quality of carving, the confident shaping of the crest rail, and the overall harmony of proportion reflect the skilled workmanship of the period. This pair offers both decorative and cultural interest, working equally well as statement pieces in a curated interior or as part of a collection of Asian furniture. Their sculptural form and mellowed surface make them particularly appealing examples of early 20th century Chinese seating.
