The rounded rectangular table top with reeded edge is in flame mahogany, which retains its superb chestnut patina. It has two leaves which can be added or removed as required to suit the occasion and can seat twelve people in comfort. It stands on three gun barrel sabre leg bases, the centre section on four outswep legs, the end sections on three legs, all the legs terminating in decoratively embossed brass castors. There is no mistaking the fine craftsmanship of this handsome dining table which is certain to become a treasured addition to your furniture collection, and a talking point with guests at meal times.
