This is a fabulous antique Queen Anne Revival burr walnut dining table by the renowned retailer and cabinet maker Maple & Co, and bearing their engraved brass label. The table dates from circa 1880. The rounded rectangular figured walnut top with moulded edge above a walnut frieze carved with rope-twist moulding. It has its original winding mechanism with winding handle and has four leaves which can be added or removed as required to suit the occasion. Its raised on four cabriole legs carved with foliate cartouches terminating in ball and claw feet with a central support leg for extra stability. The table is fitted with a Joseph Fitter Patent wind-out mechanism, bearing his brass label. The table has been French polished to revive it and bring out the beautiful grain of the burr walnut, the table can seat ten in comfort.
