Displays a desirable aged patina and in good order throughout. Select oak stocks present fine grain interest and rich caramel hues. Superb relief carvings accentuate the tall, narrow back rest and octagonal seat. The crown atop the long backrest features a delightful heart motif. Eye-catching water dragon relief to the backrest, the fins portrayed as acanthus carvings. Back rest held securely with peg joints, which can be removed for storage. Bold octagonal seat hosts a distinctive scaled tail within a wave motif. Raised upon a quartet of bobbin turned legs and adorned with carved collars. This is a fascinating antique spinning chair, beautifully decorated with skilled craftsmanship. Solid joints and construction, delivered ready for the home.
