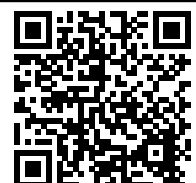
Description

Terracotta rhubarb forcer with impressed stamp for Ripon Pottery , Curtis it is in nice condition and is weathered. The original Littlethorpe Forcing Jar was designed in the 1850's for Rhubarb/Seakale forcing. The forcing jar is used to bring the crops on early and keep them sweet by denying them light. This is done by placing the jar over rhubarb crowns or seakale thongs. The base is thickly rimmed to ensure years of sturdy service. H: 21 " Diameter: 16"
