Description

Queen Anne Walnut & Crossbanded Chest on Associated Stand c.1710 DESCRIPTION An early 18th-century Queen Anne walnut chest, attractively crossbanded and quarter-veneered, raised on an associated later walnut stand. The upper section is fitted with two short drawers above two long graduated drawers, retaining an attractive arrangement of matched walnut veneers. The stand incorporates a central long drawer flanked by two deep drawers, above a shaped apron and cabriole legs terminating in spade feet. Although the stand is a later addition, it has acquired age in its own right and provides the chest with a practical working height while complementing the character of the upper section. Several of the drawers retain nineteenth-century newspaper linings, including examples dated 1826, providing an interesting glimpse into the cabinet's long history. The chest displays particularly attractive colour and figuring to the walnut veneers and would make a practical and decorative piece for a bedroom, sitting room or hallway.
