Interesting weathered Medusa head sculpture, the carved stone mount with mask and face of the mythological Gorgon with snakes. Has been exposed to the elements in a loggia setting and has acquired a distinctive weathered patina to both the stone and the metal. The verso mounted with a steel hanging hook. A striking sculpture of the mythological snake-headed Medusa, with strong visual presence and impact. In Greek mythology, Medusa was one of the three hideous Gorgon sisters, whose gaze could turn people into stone. H 22" W 14" D 10" Probably French c.1920
