It is housed in its original 17th-century Sunderland-style carved giltwood and gesso frame, a wonderful survivor that complements the painting beautifully. Having remained untouched for centuries, the painting bears the honest signs of its remarkable age. As shown in the photographs, there are various historical cosmetic imperfections to both the canvas and frame, entirely consistent with a work approaching 360 years old.
