The table features elegant, rounded ends, giving it a softer and more refined appearance than square-ended examples, while the beautifully figured top displays a rich, warm patina developed over more than a century. Supported on three Regency style pedestal bases, each with graceful swept legs terminating in original brass castors, the table offers excellent stability ...
