Each chair features a finely carved lyre-shaped splat framed by moulded uprights with gently outcurved open arms, the cane seats raised on slender tapering legs with reeded decoration. Traces of the original parcel gilding remain within the carved details, adding further character and highlighting the quality of the workmanship. Well-proportioned and decorative, these chairs would work equally well in a drawing room, hallway or bedroom, offering an elegant classical influence. Their refined proportions and attractive patina make them an appealing pair for both traditional and contemporary interiors. **DIMENSIONS** Height: 90 cm Width: 56 cm Depth: 47 cm **CONDITION** Presented in good antique condition consistent with age and use. The frames display the expected marks, knocks and surface scratches associated with nearly two centuries of use.
