The painting depicts a charming rural genre scene of four children watching a kitten drink from a shallow bowl, set against a cottage garden backdrop. Langlois was a Surrey-born artist who exhibited at the Royal Academy during the 1860s and 70s. He became known for his still lifes, landscapes and sentimental domestic subjects in oil and watercolour.
