A handsome and honest example, retaining its original top, base and drop leaves, with a rich, deep colour and well-developed patina acquired over more than three centuries. The rectangular top incorporates two drop leaves, supported on swinging gate legs, allowing the table to be used either as a compact side table or fully extended as a practical side, lamp or occasional table. It stands on attractively turned baluster legs united by plain stretchers, all displaying pleasing proportions typical of the Queen Anne period.
