This gorgeous early Victorian antique writing table in the manner of Gillows was crafted from beautiful pollard oak and dates from Circa 1870. The rectangular top with rounded corners features a striking tan inset leather writing surface that has beautiful hand tooled gilt decoration. It has two useful drawers and is raised on decorative trestle ends joined by a turned stretcher terminating in scroll feet and raised on brass castors. It is finished on all sides so that it can stand freely in the middle of a room, making it extremely suitable for a large home.
