This is a fabulous antique late Victorian flame mahogany with scrolling satin wood marquetry decoration, Wellington chest, circa 1880 in date. It is attributed to the famous cabinet maker Jas Shoolbred & Co. The chest stands on a plinth base and has eight graduating drawers each beautifully inlaid with floral motifs. It has an ingenious locking flap which means that you can lock all the drawers with one key. The drawers are very spacious, provide loads of storage, and have their original brass ring pull handles. It is a spectacular piece which would look amazing in any room.
