The satin black dial has just been professionally restored to new condition. The attention to detail is what makes these IWC watches stand out from other manufacturers. The movement has Pelaton automatic winding, the most efficient winding system but very expensive to make. The movement incorporates a rapid date set facility allowing you to set the date in a few seconds. It has a heavy 9ct gold water-resistant case with armoured glass. The 9ct gold armoured water-resistant versions of the 8541 are exceedingly rare. As you would expect, the watch is fully marked on the dial, movement, and case. The watch case measures 35mm in diameter, not including the crown. It can be supplied with a new leather strap of any colour or style you prefer. Th...
