Displaying the commanding visual stature characteristic of late 19th-century Chinese furniture, this pair offers a distinctively striking sculptural presence. They serve as exceptional statement pieces when positioned symmetrically in a spacious entrance hall, a formal drawing room or flanking a library hearth. Very good antique condition, retaining a rich, layered historic dark lacquer finish with rich ruby undertones, stable craquelure and honest wear.
