Étagères, or Whatnots as they are perhaps more commonly known in England, have remained popular for generations thanks to their elegant appearance and remarkable versatility within the home. This is an especially attractive example, constructed using beautifully figured rosewood veneers, retaining a good rich colour and striking natural grain to each of the three tiers. The elegant turned supports, turned finials and brass cup castors combine to create a design which is both refined and practical, whilst the proportions are particularly pleasing. Extremely versatile, this piece can be used to display books, porcelain, bronzes, sculptures or decorative objects and is equally at home in a drawing room, library, hallway or study. Its compact proportions ensure that it is large enough to make an impression whilst remaining easy to accommodate within a wide variety of interiors.
