All pieces are Good Clean and sound. Each approximately 2cm high. (3cm with peg) Box closed 10in or 25.5cm x 5in or 12.5cm x 1.75in or 4.5cm. When in Play the side bar is removed to reveal a Playing Area 8.5in or 21.5cm square. The Case is also Good & Sound Structure with only minor signs of use in keeping with it's age and design.
