Description

A late 19th century cast iron stick stand by Coalbrookdale, the arched Neoclassical cresting centred by an anthemion motif flanked by foliate decoration and central embossed foundry mark, set over a divided upper retaining rail, above an openwork lattice back panel ornamented with floral rosettes within pointed foliate mounts, on a plinth base housing the original lift-out cast iron drip tray. Later painted, bearing both the raised foundry stamp and an 1885 registration number cast into the lower side scrolls, the stand retains its correct removable drip tray. The slim rectangular footprint sits flush against hallway or vestibule walls. Very good antique condition, with attractive wear to the painted surfaces and a small historic loss to one drip tray handle. Structurally sound and ready for placement. English, circa 1885.
