The box comes complete with a Victorian period padlock which secures the catch at the front, the original key is used to lock and unlock the padlock. The underside is fully marked for the top-notch silversmith, Mappin and Webb Company, Sheffield; 71 & 72 Cornhill, City; 72 & 73 Oxford St. London.
