Striking shield back with scrolled leaf crest rail, meeting in a double pediment. Back splat hosts long scrolls to the edge with a shield motif within the centre. Tapered seat squab set at a comfortable height of 44cm (17.25"). Distinctive butler's grasp to the reverse for ease of placement. Delightful turned baluster legs at the front over peg feet. Rear legs gently splayed with square section toes. This is an appealing antique hall chair, offering superb colour and a striking form. Solid joints and construction, delivered ready for the home.
