Form & Profile: Robustly potted compressed globular vessel featuring a stepped rim, a raised band of characteristic round bosses (studs), and a finely incised scrolling floral or diaper border around the midsection. Handles: Twin crisply molded rope-twist loop handles securely affixed to the rim, glazed in a luminous sea-green tone that pools deep within the rope crevices. Feet & Base: Raised on three dynamic lion-mask feet. The unglazed circular base ring and interior floor reveal the authentic, fiery reddish-brown biscuit body that burns to a rich orange-buff hue from traditional regional kiln firing. The base also bears the distinct green collection sticker reading "The G S. May Esquire Private Collection, London, 353". Glaze: Thick, translucent, and evenly applied sea-green celadon glaze featuring an intricate, well...
