A superb pair of wax portrait reliefs by Richard Cockle Lucas, British, 1800-1883, in convex glazed giltwood frames, Circa 1850 in date. The wax portraits are of Mr and Mrs W H Blaauw, dated 1851 and 1852, Mr Blaauw depicted wearing a coat, Mrs Blaauw with her hair in a chignon and ringlets, each on brown wax ground, the gentleman's inscribed on the ground R C Lucas W H Blaauw F.S.A. Beechland Sussex 1852, the lady's ground inscribed R C Lucas Mrs Blaauw Beechland Sussex 1851, Provenance: Bonhams, New Bond Street, Sale No. 31218 Fine Portrait Miniatures, 5 November 2002, lot 2. Note: Richard Cockle Lucas (1800-1883) is predominantly known as a sculptor in wax, but he also worked in glass, marble and bronze, as well as being a painter. He began his career as a sculptor as an apprentice to his uncle, who worked as a cutler in Winchester, carving knife handles. He joined the Royal Academy Schools in 1828 and studied under Richard Westmacott. He exhibited at the Royal Academy between 1829 and 1859 and showed his work at the Great Exhibition in 1851.
