A rare and superb cold painted bronze sculpture by Édouard Guy Compte du Passage (1872-1925). The sculpture is cast in bronze depicting a kingfisher sitting in reeds as though he were watching the water for fish. It is raised on the original black navette shaped marble base and is signed E Guy on the bronze. Edouard Guy Compte du Passage is well known for his sculptures of animals and was compared favourably to Antoine-Louis Barye (1796-1875). However, towards the end of his life he embraced the Art Deco movement. This piece is possibly his only Art Deco bronze which he produced before he died in 1925.
