Description

An impressive antique Queen Anne style burr walnut console table dating from the early 20th century, distinguished by its generous proportions, richly figured veneers and elegant cabriole-leg form. The long rectangular top is veneered in beautifully figured burr walnut, displaying the swirling grain, warm colour and natural variation for which the timber is prized. Below are two substantial drawers, each faced in matching burr walnut and fitted with decorative brass handles, providing useful storage while maintaining the table's refined symmetry. The drawers are raised above a deeply shaped and pierced apron, introducing movement and decorative rhythm across the unusually wide façade. Four graceful cabriole legs terminate in classic pad feet, giving the piece the elegant profile associated with Queen Anne furniture while providing a sturdy and practical foundation. At 152 cm wide, this is a particularly versatile example. It would work superbly as a hallway console, drawing-room side table, serving table, or statement piece behind a sofa. Its restrained form allows it to complement both traditional interiors and more contemporary rooms seeking the warmth...
