A rare, architectural Late Victorian terracotta chimney pot featuring an integral vented cowl capped with a turned acorn/bud finial. Manufactured in the late 19th century (circa 1880s), this distinct pot is stamped on the lower section of the collar with the maker's mark: "PATENTED - C. R. STEVENS - EXHAUST COWL" (Registered/patented in Lewisham, London, c. 1882). Designed to draw smoke upwards and prevent downdraughts, this piece showcases beautiful historical utility paired with decorative Victorian craftsmanship. The terracotta has acquired a fantastic naturally weathered patina. Ideal as a standout garden feature, planter stand, architectural display piece, or re-installed on a period property restoration. Approximate Measurements: Height 120cm, Diameter at base 33cm, Diameter at widest 41cm. Condition Report: Overall: Strong, solid display condition with authentic outdoor weathering. Flaws to Note: * A stress crack runs across one of the structural vertical uprights near the vent ring (visible in close-up photos). This appears to be firm and still structurally solid. Minor surface hairline/firing stress to the base of the top finial. Typical light n...
