Fine William and Mary Burled and Figured Walnut Sectaire Chest. A diminutive and fine quality late 17th/early 18th century (William and Mary period) secretaire chest. Featuring highly figured veneers throughout, it features an ogee map drawer over a fall front opening to a finely fitted interior, with central prospect door opening to three interior drawers. Surrounded by 14 additional drawers and three hidden drawers. A fine emerald green velvet lined writing surface, and a lower case with four conforming long drawers, fine gilt and engraved brass pulls and escutcheons throughout. Keys points of note are: The fine burled and figured veneers used throughout. A rich deep honey coloured patina. Rare and diminutive proportions. Unmolested state. Highly competitive cost.
