Description

Pair of early C19th Regency period bronze campana-shaped reversible candlestick cassiolettes and pastille burners of classical urn design. The campana urn bodies with removable and reversible covers with cast berry finials. The reversed top then forming a candle-holder of gently sloping form. The rims of the vases with cast fluted decoration, with the lids removed the inside of the body having a circular shaped holder to accommodate a block of scented pastille for burning to add perfumed fragrance to a room. The lower part of the bodies having gadrooned cast decoration and raised on turned socle supports onto square plinth bases. The sides of the vases each with loop handles. In excellent original condition with a dark, consistent colour and patina. H 8.5" W 5" D 5" England c.1820
