Beyond the tree lies a tranquil bay painted in rich ultramarine and turquoise tones. Short, broken brushstrokes suggest the movement of sunlight across the water, while several small white boats float quietly at anchor, reinforcing the calm, leisurely mood. Across the harbour sits a compact coastal village of whitewashed buildings with warm ochre roofs nestled at the foot of steep hills. At its centre rises a white church with a slender bell tower, acting as the visual focal point and giving the settlement both rhythm and identity. The surrounding mountains are painted in warm russets, golds, and olive greens, with cool blue shadows describing their contours and adding depth to the landscape. The foreground shoreline is painted in creamy yellows and sandy ochres, punctuated by touches of crimson, violet, and green that suggest wildflowers or sunlit vegetation. These colours echo those in the tree and hills, creating a harmonious palette that unifies the composition. Lucy Pratt's handling of paint is confident and economical.
