Antique Art Nouveau stoneware vase hand-decorated by the renowned senior Royal Doulton artist Florrie Jones, dating to the early 20th century (circa 1902–1920). An unusual and delightful colour combination. 18cm in height. Artist Profile: Florrie Jones worked as a Senior Assistant and decorator at the Lambeth studio from the late 19th century until at least 1928. She frequently collaborated with major designers like Eliza Simmance and Vera Huggins. Design Elements: This specific style features vibrant, stylized organic or peacock-feather motifs utilizing tubelined/slip-trailed detailing, mottled colorful glazes, and textured geometric accents characteristic of the British Art Nouveau movement. Markings: Authentic pieces carry her incised "FJ" monogram alongside the stamped Royal Doulton Lambeth factory emblem on the base

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
