## Description

A particularly high quality Queen Anne Burr walnut and solid walnut linen press in excellent condition and retaining original removable oak shelves and original hardware including the beautifully cast solid brass escutcheons and heavy teardrop brass drawer handles on flower back plates. . Made by very skilled hands in c. 1700 . The upper case with a wainscot oak carcass dressed in book matched burr walnut veneers to door frames and to the wide stepped and splayed ogee shaped cornice and side panels. The pair of solid walnut panel doors and fielded and framed in burr walnut and enhanced with moulded walnut borders. Both doors open and close smoothly with no warps and with original escutcheon central lock and an early, possibly original, working key. The left hand door retains its pierced brass inner slide bolts . The equally substantial lower case with matching burr walnut veneers to drawer fronts, plinth and side panels – all of fantastic colour - and with lovely carved walnut thumb and ogee moulded borders at the waist and plinth. . The whole set on very large and early bun feet and with six graduated oak lined original drawers with rebated runners and steel locks. The d...
