A striking ruby dress ring centred by a fine, raspberry red ruby - certified as natural, unheated and originating from the Mong Hsu mines in Myanmar (Burma). The principal ruby is framed by an elaborate cluster of twenty round brilliant cut diamond accented by a further four round rubies in an ornate floral design. A wonderful late twentieth century statement piece. Accompanied by a ruby report from The Gem & Pearl Laboratory stating the ruby shows no indications of heating, and is Burmese (Myanmar) in origin, from Mong Hsu. Cut: The main ruby is an oval cut. The small rubies are round cuts. The diamonds are round brilliant cuts. Colour: The diamonds are G to H. Clarity: The ruby has some visible inclusions (which is expected in rubies). The diamonds range from VS2 to SI1. Carat: The central ruby is 1.57 carat, with a further 0.04 carat in the surround. The total approximate diamond weight is 1.16 carat. Size: O 1/2 (UK) or 7 1/4 (US). Free sizing available. Measurements: The ruby is 9.7 x 5.6mm. The head of the ring is 27.9 x 17.5mm and sits 7.8mm from the finger. Weight: 10.09 grams.
