DESCRIPTION A fine George I period figured walnut escritoire, dating to circa 1715–1725, of elegant proportions and retaining an exceptionally attractive fitted interior. The moulded cornice sits above a cushion-moulded frieze drawer and a quarter-veneered, feather-banded fall front, opening to reveal a beautifully arranged writing interior fitted with an array of ebony-strung pigeonholes, small drawers, shaped dividers and a central cupboard, providing both visual interest and practical storage. The lower section is fitted with three long crossbanded drawers, raised on shaped bracket feet. The figured walnut veneers display an attractive colour and pleasing grain throughout, complemented by the contrasting ebony stringing and refined early eighteenth-century proportions. A handsome and practical George I period escritoire, combining elegant cabinet making with a highly decorative and functional interior. **DIMENSIONS** Height: 177cm Width: 101cm Depth: 56cm **CONDITION** The escritoire displays the expected light marks, knocks and surface wear associated with over three hundred years of age and use. There are some minor losses, historic repairs and small splits to the veneers,...
