This heavy measure, used to calibrate dry goods such as grain and cereals, is engraved for the 'ORANJE VRY STAAT' The Orange Free State of South Africa, and dated 1875. It is made by POTTER, LONDON and numbered 1592, it also features Customs & Excise stamps for Queen Victoria but these are very worn and only just visible. These very fine quality measures were used by Customs & Excise to check that market traders did not under-sell their customers by supplying short amounts.
