A mid 18th century country-made oak stool, the curved single-slab hand-carved saddle seat with exposed wedged through-tenons, set over four splayed legs united by staggered pegged stretchers. Carved directly from a solid log section to maximise structural mass, the heavy-gauge oak slab exhibits an extraordinary surface history from generations of use. Its pronounced splayed stance provides a wide, stable footprint, making it ideal as an occasional stool, fireside seat or simply as a sculptural accent in a hallway or beside a hearth. Very good antique condition, retaining an exceptional aged patina and timber character, with historic replacement stretchers to the rear and one side.
