William III is depicted bust length within an oval composition wearing magnificent royal state robes, an ermine lined mantle, elaborate lace cravat and the ceremonial Collar of the Order of the Garter with the suspended Great George. The Portrait William's pale features are framed by a long dark allonge periwig characteristic of the late Stuart court. The combination of patterned fabric, ermine, lace and Garter insignia creates an imposing image of monarchy and chivalric authority.
