Constructed from mahogany, ash and pine. A simple and useful piece of furniture. The size is rare, Scotch chests are more typically large and heavy with six deep drawers enclosed by large turned columns. This example is far more restrained, the decorative interest being its size, the quality of the timber and the shaped serpentine top. Well presented overall, nice quality timber.
