The Cumaean Sibyl, depicted on the left, is portrayed with an air of mystique, holding a scroll that signifies her prophetic wisdom. Her flowing garments and expressive features embody the grace and intensity of her character. In contrast, the Persian Sibyl on the right exudes authority, adorned in regal attire that highlights her status. She is often depicted with a staff, symbolizing her role as a seer. Both paintings are framed in their original hand-carved and gilded frame, enhancing their grandeur and historical significance, making them not only artworks but also treasures of cultural heritage.
