The chandelier has a vase shaped central column with bulbous body, terminating to six substantial scroll arms, finished with gadroon finial underneath. The chandelier retains its original bronze finish which glows beautifully when illuminated. The light hangs on a 50cm chain, which can be shortened, and it comes with a 12.5cm wide ceiling rose hook. The chandelier has been rewired, tested and is in working order. Height - 58 cm (23 inches) Width - 78 cm (30 ¾ inches) Depth - 78 cm (30 ¾ inches) Circa - 1900 Faraday was established by Robert Faraday in 1817, whose brother was the famous English scientist Michael Faraday.
