A figure can be seen sat on a bank near a small pond, as a woman approaches with a basket. Beyond the path lies a cornfield where other figures are shown harvesting wheat and stacking them into shocks. Walter Heath Williams was a landscape painter who was working from the early 1840's until the late 1870's. Little is known about Williams's life and he is often confused with the artist Walter Williams (1834-1906) and William Williams of Plymouth (1808-1895) who both exhibited at the Royal Academy. It is possible that this was a pseudonym for another artist, a device often used by artists who were contracted to work for a gallery. Although he rarely signed his work, his paintings are distinctive with his use of fine brushstrokes, a soft palette and glowing light. He is known to have painted landscapes, particularly harvest scenes as well as river views and was a master of cap...
