The piece features its original hessian webbing, burlap panels, and exposed dark horsehair stuffing to the backrest. The frame stands on simple square tapered legs with a good historic color and patina. The timber structure remains solid and usable. A lovely decorative item for a bedroom, hallway, or eclectic interior. Good stable condition. The frame is structurally sound with minor historic bumps, scuffs, and wear consistent with age. Upholstery is stripped down to the base layers as shown. Seat height 30cm. Size 73cm H x 50cm W x 52cm D. Dimensions taken across the widest points.
