Attributed to the renowned cabinet maker Thomas Pistor, this highly decorative chest is an outstanding example of the sophisticated English cabinet-making of the period. The chest features the distinctive two short over two long drawer configuration, beautifully veneered throughout in richly figured Kingwood oyster veneers, creating a dramatic and intricate radiating pattern. Further enhanced with rosewood cross-banding, adding depth and definition to the elaborate veneer work. Constructed with a solid oak carcass and finely dovetailed drawers.
