These beautiful large urns are in excellent original condition with no cracks or damage. . The paint work is quite old and there are some superficial stains and a little light rusting in areas – all normal for cast iron garden furniture and they can be repainted or left to age naturally. . The plinth can be detached on one but on the other it has become fixed. . These are very heavy items and our courier will require at least one very strong pair of hands to help him offload. . A rarely seen large and true pair of genuine Victorian cast iron urns on original stands in the manner of Coalbrookdale . . Dimensions are: .
